IPEDS is an abbreviation for Integrated Postsecondary Education Data Systems; their website is <http://nces.ed.gov/ipeds/>.

Every university in the U.S. that receives money from the federal government submits data to the U.S. Department of Education, which is made public.

IPEDS data does not include medical school basic science faculty; Pitt's AAUP data does. Thus, Pitt's AAUP faculty salaries are much (\$1000s) higher than IPEDS.

For faculty salaries among the public AAU universities for 2009-10, the IPEDS Data Base shows that Pitt ranks:

21 out of 35 for full professor (**P**) salaries.

22 out of 35 for associate professor (**AO**) salaries.

31 out of 35 for assistant professor (**AI**) salaries.

19 out of 27 for instructor (**IN**) salaries (8 public AAU peers do not have any instructors by IPEDS criteria).

29 out of 31 for lecturer (**Lect**) salaries (4 public AAU peers do not have any lecturers by IPEDS criteria).

16 out of 19 for no rank (**NR**) salaries (16 public AAU peers do not have any no rank faculty by IPEDS criteria).

32 out of 35 for all ranks (**AR**) salaries.

The All Ranks (**AR**) faculty salary category reflects the disparity between the number of higher paid faculty versus the number of lower paid faculty at a university.

The lower the **AR salary**, the greater the disparity. **Pitt has one of the lowest AR (All Ranks) average salary (#32 out of 35 for 2009-10) of the public AAU universities.**

The ratio **AR/P** (the All Ranks average salary divided by the full professor salary) reflects the disparity between the salaries of full professors and lower paid faculty.

The lower the **AR/P** ratio, the greater the disparity. **Pitt has one of the lowest AR/P ratios (#34 out of 35 for 2009-10) of the public AAU universities.**

The **%P** (% full professors) is the percentage of the faculty who have been promoted to full professor by an institution.

The lower the **%P**, the lower the total cost of faculty salaries at a university. **Pitt has the lowest %P (#35 out of 35 for 2009-10) of the public AAU universities.**

Average faculty salaries for Pitt's Regional Campuses versus averages for Pitt's 34 public AAU peer group, Pitt (Pittsburgh), Penn State (University Park) and Temple.
